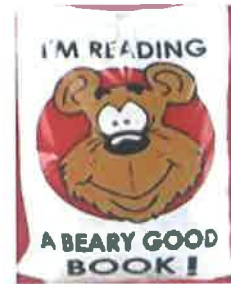

Welcome Back to another year of library.

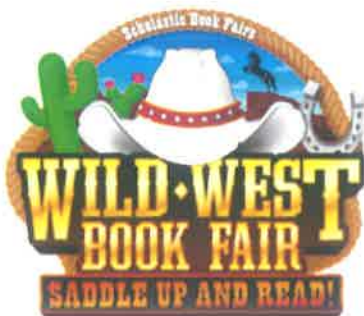
ECS—Gr. 9 students will visit the library once a week for library checkouts, starting the week of September 7.
