

GRADE ONE SUPPLY LIST 2017 - 2018

20	HB pencils (must be HB as generic pencils do not sharpen properly). <i>Please send these sharpened and names on pencils are not required.</i>
2	Boxes of large twistable crayons (not fluorescent and no more than 24 pack)
2	Boxes of pencil crayons (please send these sharpened, 24 pack)
8	White vinyl erasers
1	Pair of pointed scissors (good quality scissors are important to help with proper cutting)
3	Large glue sticks (40 grams, preferably yellow ones)
1	Bottle of white glue (150 ml)
1	½ interlined, Hilroy Exercise scribbler (23.1 cm x 18 cm - 72 pages) GREEN
1	Hilroy Exercise scribbler (40 pages, large full page, 8 ½ x 11 [27.6 cm x 21.3 cm])
1	Hard pencil case
2	Pocket <u>plastic</u> portfolios (not a binder or a duotang)
1	backpack
1	Pair of good, athletic indoor running shoes that the student is able to fasten. Shoes are to be left at school. (NOT BLACK SOLED). Skateboarding, platform style, or slip-on shoes are not acceptable). Velcro closures are preferred if students are unable to tie shoelaces.
4	Large ziploc bags, or you may purchase a Kanga Pouch from the school for \$10.00
1	Computer headset (available at most Dollar Stores)
1	Pencil sharpener with a <u>screw on lid and is able to contain shavings</u>
1	Old paint shirt that will be used for painting and will be kept at the school
1	Old large sock
