Dear Families,

As we step into the month of February, I wanted to share a reflection on a powerful presentation I recently attended, hosted by the Northern Alberta Internet Child Exploitation (NAICE) Unit. The session was truly impactful, offering a sobering but necessary look at the digital landscape our children navigate every day. One of the most significant takeaways for me was a simple yet profound truth: the best gift we can provide our children is not the latest device or a new app, but our presence. In an age of constant connectivity, being truly present and available is our greatest tool for building trust.


It actually took me back to when I was a teenager and the internet was brand new. I remember being at a sleepover, and the first thing we did was hop into a chatroom to talk to strangers. It felt so exciting and "grown-up" to talk to people from all over the world. But looking back, the idea of "stranger danger" was totally out the window. Would I have told my parents? No way. I thought they wouldn't get it and would just get mad. That feeling, that our "parents just don't understand" (solidified in our own childhood by the Fresh Prince and DJ Jazzy Jeff) is exactly what we need to break down with our own kids today.

The truth is, we need to give ourselves some grace. None of us were raised by parents who had to deal with TikTok, Snapchat, or AI. We are learning this as we go, and it's okay to admit we don't have all the answers. The stats show that technology is changing how our kids see relationships, and online risks like sextortion are growing. Our best defense isn't a fancy software block; it's being willing to have those super "awkward conversations" before something goes wrong.

It's really easy to just say "no" when a kid asks for a new app, but we have to remember how we were at that age. When we were told no, we just found sneakier ways to do it anyway. If we just shut them down, they'll stop telling us what's happening in their digital lives. We want them to know that if they ever get into a mess online, we aren't going to freak out or blame them. We want them to know we are on their team, no matter what.

While things like parental controls on iPhones or Androids are great tools to help out, they can't replace a good old-fashioned heart-to-heart. This month, I'm encouraging all of us to just be there. Listen more than you lecture, and let them know that no matter how weird or scary things get online, they can always come to you. When we are present and approachable, we become the safety net they truly need.







Winter has officially arrived!

Dear Caledonia Park Parents and Guardians.

As the forecast shifts and we begin to see consistently colder temperatures, we want to send out a friendly but important reminder about proper winter attire.

To ensure all students can safely enjoy their time outdoors, which is crucial for their well-being and focus, we ask for your help in preparing them daily.

Indoor recesses will obviously be called when necessary (when the temperature and conditions are deemed unsafe), but being prepared to go out should always be the default.

THE ESSENTIAL CHECKLIST



Please ensure your child comes to school each day with the following items:

- Warm Winter Jacket: Fully zipped up for the cold.
- Snow Pants: Essential for playing in the snow and staying dry.
- Hat: Critical for retaining body heat.
- Gloves or Mittens: A warm, waterproof pair is best.
- Warm, Waterproof Boots: To keep feet dry and comfortable.



REPORTING A STUDENT ABSENCE

SAFE ARRIVAL

With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

- **On your mobile device:**
- Using your mobile device, download and install the **SchoolMessenger Home** app from the [Apple App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#). Download the app with the following icon:

- The first time you use the app, select **Sign Up** to create your account.
- Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- **Use the SchoolMessenger website:**
- Go to the [SchoolMessenger website](#). The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account.
- Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- **By telephone:**
- Call the toll-free number **780-955-4526** to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.

The automated notification system will attempt to contact parents at multiple contact points (email, text, push notification & phone call) until a reason is submitted for the absence. If our system is unable to reach the designated contacts, office staff will follow up.

If you report your child's absence in advance using the **SafeArrival** toll-free number, website or mobile app, you will NOT receive these notifications.

Please download the SchoolMessenger Home app or sign into the website before this date. If you are having trouble logging in, please contact your school.

If you do not already receive text message from your school and would like to start, please ensure your school has your mobile phone number and then text "Y" to 978338. (Standard message and data rates may apply.)

You may also contact the school and leave a detailed message after hours (780-986-7888)

Good attendance patterns are an important factor in a student's overall success at school.

Did you know? Key facts about school attendance:

- If your child is 20 minutes late every day, he/she/they will have missed 12 days of instruction by the end of the school year.
- If your child misses only two days of school per month, he/she/they will have missed one month's worth of instruction by the end of the school year.
- Students who are absent 15 days of school each year will have lost one year of instruction by the end of Grade 12.
- Students who attend school regularly tend to be more engaged in their learning, feel more connected to the school and have better academic outcomes than students who miss a lot of school.

Families can support good attendance at school by:

- setting a regular bedtime and morning routine;
- getting clothes and backpacks ready the night before;
- encouraging a positive attitude about school;
- communicating regularly with your child's teacher;
- talking with your child about his/her school day;
- taking part in school events and activities to show your child that you value school and education;
- planning vacations and appointments around the school schedule whenever possible; and
- making sure your child goes to school unless he/she/they is truly sick.

We can help!

Let your school know right away if there is a problem or concern. There are many ways we can work together to get attendance back on track or prevent an attendance problem from starting.
